



Example: *a police station (a place) London Police Station (the name of a place)

*a post office (a place) City Post Office (the name of a place)

*a = one, if there is more than one, add "s"

Example: There is a supermarket.

There is a flower shop. There is a police station.

To ask a question about a place in your city, use the form: Is there a... (in your city)?

Example: Is there a bank in your city? Yes, there is./No, there isn't.

Is there a post office? Yes, there is./No, there isn't. Is there a hotel in your city? Yes, there is./No, there isn't.

To talk about where you are going to go, use the form: I am going to the....

Example: I am going to the salon.


I am going to the library. I am going to the school.


