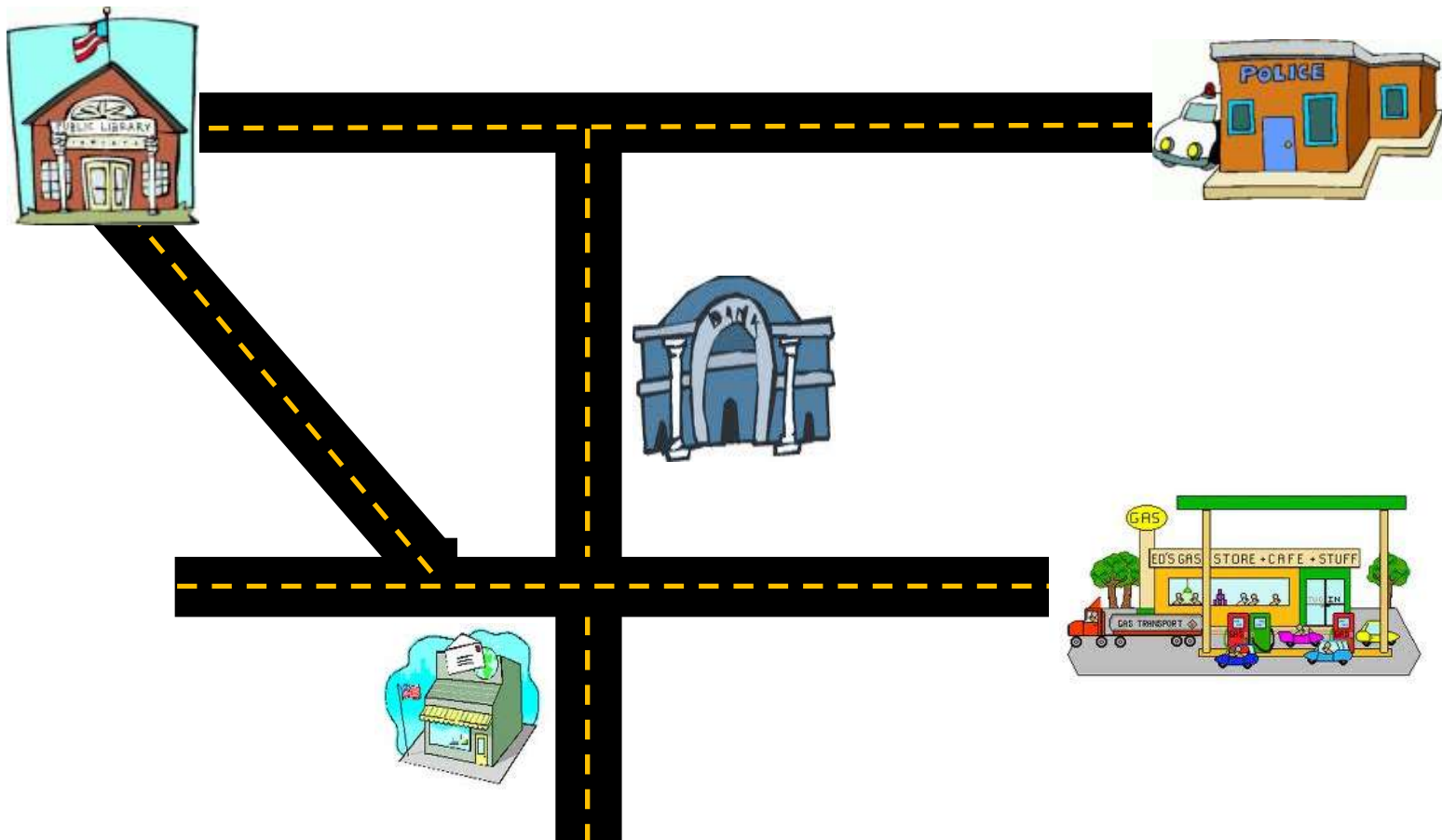

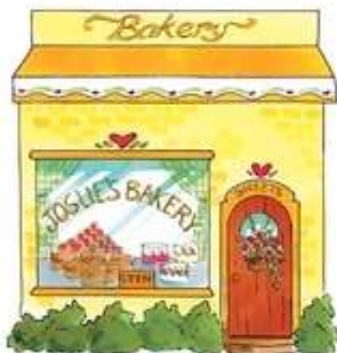

## Language Tip

3-5 minutes

A place is *only* capitalized if it is the name of the place.

Example:    \*a police station (a place)                  London Police Station (the name of a place)  
                 \*a post office (a place)                      City Post Office (the name of a place)

\*a = one, if there is more than one, add "s"

## Places around town

5-10 minutes

To talk about places in your city you can use the form: *There is a...*

Example:    There is a supermarket.  
                 There is a flower shop.  
                 There is a police station.

To ask a question about a place in your city, use the form: *Is there a... (in your city)?*

Example:    Is there a bank in your city?                  Yes, there is./No, there isn't.  
                 Is there a post office?                      Yes, there is./No, there isn't.  
                 Is there a hotel in your city?                  Yes, there is./No, there isn't.

To talk about where you are going to go, use the form: *I am going to the...*






Example:    I am going to the salon.  
                 I am going to the library.  
                 I am going to the school.

To ask where someone is going, use the form: *Where are you going?*
