







To ask a person's profession, use

What do you do? (general)

What do you do for a living? (specific)

Telling your profession

To respond to the question about jobs, say

I'm a / an + profession

Telling about your job:

To indicate more information you can use

I work in a / an + place.

I work at / for + company name.
