# The position of Adjectives

8 min

An adjective can be used before a noun. **Examples:** a *new* boat a *big* house

It can be used after some verbs. **Examples:** It is *difficult*. She looks *pretty*.

It can be used after an indefinite pronoun, like "something", "someone".

### Examples:

I need to drink something warm.

She met someone *smart*.

It is possible to use several adjectives. In this case, the order is from general to specific:
