When do we use the present perfect?

Unspecified time before now	She <i>has been</i> on a plane.
Something that started in the past and is	You <i>have lived</i> in Cambridge since 2008.
continuing today	

How do we form the present perfect? *have/has + past participle*

Affirmative form 🗸

Regular Verbs	Irregular verbs
to work	to go
I/you/we/they <i>have worked</i>	I/you/we/they <i>have gone</i>
he/she/it <i>has worked</i>	he/she/it <i>has gone</i>

Negative form×

Regular Verbs	Irregular verbs
to work	to go
I/you/we/they <i>have not worked</i>	I/you/we/they <i>have not gone</i>
he/she/it <i>has not worked</i>	he/she/it <i>has not gone</i>

Question

Regular Verbs	Irregular verbs
to work	to go
Have I/you/we/they worked?	Have I/you/we/they gone?
Has he/she/it worked?	Has he/she/it gone?

Examples:

Have you ever been to South America?

Yes, I have been to South America. = Yes, I have.

No, I have not/never been to South America. = No, I have not.

When we speak, we use contractions. A contraction is two words put together.

Examples:

haven't = have not hasn't = has not
